## Traditional Log Cabin 10" Block



Your packet should have 1 red 2.5" square for the center (chimney or hearth), and 1.5 " strips (logs) in light and dark fabrics in varying lengths. There is only one 2.5 " strip (\#1 light) and one 10.5" strip (\#16 dark). There are two strips, one light and one dark, of each of these sizes: 3.5 ", 4.5 ", $5.5^{\prime \prime}$, $6.5^{\prime \prime}, 7.5^{\prime \prime}, 8.5$ " and 9.5 ". For your convenience, the fabric strips have been stacked in the order in which they will be used. If you are missing or lose a strip, or have a "mishap", feel free to substitute with your own fabric that fits in with the rest.

Sew the 2.5" light strip (\#1) to the red center square. Press to the \#1 strip. Turn the piece one quarter turn to the right (clockwise), then sew on the 3.5" light strip (\#2). Press to strip \#2. Again, turn the piece one quarter turn to the right. Sew on 3.5" dark strip (\#3), then press to strip \#3. Proceed with each strip in numerical order, pressing to the strip you just sewed on, then turning the piece clockwise one quarter turn.

After sewing on strip \#4, the unit should measure 4.5" square.
After sewing on strip \#8, the unit should measure 6.5" square.
After sewing on strip \#12, the unit should measure 8.5 " square.
After sewing on strip \#14, the block is complete and should measure 10.5" square.
