

USE UP YOUR SCRAPS TO MAKE SOMEONE HAPPY!!

EASY BLOCKS

ROMAN STRIPE

Blocks finish to 8 1/2" for both Big Kids and Little Kids



Set the blocks 5 x 7 for L.K. (42 1/2" x 59 1/2") and 6 x 8 for Big Kids (51" x 68")

Yardage:

Big Kids: 3/4 yard each of three fabrics  
2 yards for background  
Little Kids: 1/2 yd. each of three fabrics  
1 1/2 yards background

HOW?

Cut 2 1/2" strips out of 3 colors and also a 6 1/2" strip of background for each set.



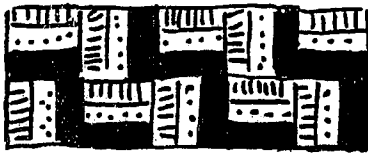
Sew the 3 strips together. Place right-sides-together with background strip. Sew a 1/4" seam on both top and bottom edge.

Use a triangle-ruler or cut a template that measures 8 1/2" per side -- with seams, 9 3/8".

Place as shown on diagram above, mark and cut. Open and press (you can easily pull out the stitches across point.) Place in the arrangement you like. CAREFUL: BIAS STRETCHES.

1/2 yd for binding

RAIL FENCE



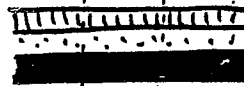
Blocks finish to 6" for L. K. set 7 x 10 (42" x 60") --

CUT 2 1/2" STRIPS! -- Yardage: 1 yd. each color

Blocks finish to 9" for B.K. set 6 x 8 (54" x 72") --

CUT 3 1/2" strips! -- Yardage: 1 1/2 yds. each color

HOW?



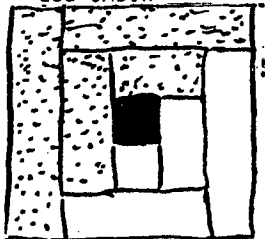
Make 6 1/2" cuts L.K., 9 1/2" cuts B.K.

Sew strips together in sets of 3. Make 12 sets for Little Kids and cut them into 70 6 1/2" squares.

Make 12 sets for Big Kids, and cut them into 48 9 1/2" squares.

Set the blocks in a "rail-fence" design.

LOG CABIN

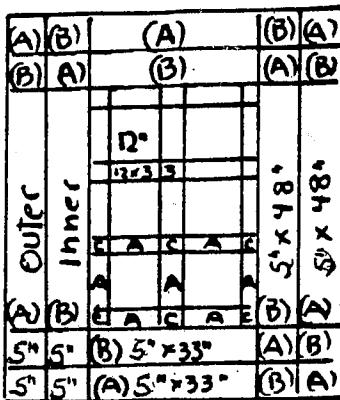


Use 2 1/2" cut strips, which finish to 2", for a 10" block. For Little Kids, make 24 blocks, set 4 x 6 (40" x 60") For Big Kids, make 35 blocks, set 5 x 7 (50" x 70") Set the blocks in your preferred arrangement

Approximate yardage:

Big Kids: 1/4 yd. center, 2 yds. light, 2 1/2 yds. dark  
L. Kid: 1/8 yd. center, 1 1/2 yds. light, 2 yds. dark

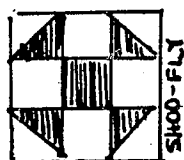
SAMPLER



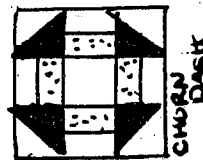
Use any 12" blocks that you like, or have. Separate the blocks with a 3" (cut 3 1/2") lattice on each side. Add two 5" (cut 5 1/2") borders to each side...53" x 68"

Yardage: 2 yards color A, 2 yards color B, 3/4 yard color C, 1 yard background....this makes blocks also--

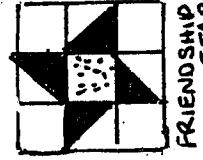
If you already have blocks, you'll only need borders and lattice: 1 1/2 yds. A for border (pieced) and lattice; 1 yard B for border; 1/4 yd. C for lattice squares.



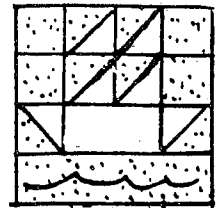
