Handy Dandies for the Adventurousome Quilter Dec. 2010

Quilts a block at a time

(QUILTING EACH BLOCK THEN ASSEMBLING THE QUILT)

- 1. Quilt all your blocks and trim them to EXACTLY the same size.**
- 2. You need 2 *strips* for each section: 1- 1 inch strip which will be on the front of your quilt & 1- 1 ¾ inch strip pressed in half edge to edge for the back.**
- 3. Pin the 1 inch strip along the edge of your block (right sides together) and the bigger one on the back lining up all the raw edges. Sew through all layers with a quarter inch seam.**
- 4. Get the next block you want to join up and line the other un-sewn edge of the 1 inch strip only to the edge of the block right sides together. Sew. Press all seams.**
- 5. Flip over the back strip and slip stitch it in place.**
- 6. Keep adding blocks into rows. Joining the rows together is the same method but using bigger joining strips - keep measuring.**

No huge pieces of batting or fabric to struggle with, a fun way to quilt on your home machine!!
