The Rolling Star Block!

Finally, you get to see how your fabrics work together, and hopefully you are happy! I love this block - it looks so complex but really it is made from the 3 very simple units you have been working on for the last 3 months.

You will be assembling 30 (or 16) Rolling Star blocks using Units 1, 2, and 3.

Hint: When assembling your blocks, carefully pin the points of the square in a square units so they match exactly as you assemble the blocks. This will give you a really polished look (again, judges watch out!) Also, instead of pressing to one side, try pressing your seams open to reduce bulk when it comes time to quilt either by machine or hand.

Use one of the Ziploc bags you just emptied, and put your finished blocks in it as you construct the rest of the quilt top (yes there is more to come!)
