## STEP 3

Cut a $21 / 2$ " strip from your feature fabric. Then cut a $41 / 2 "$ strip from the background fabric and a $101 / 2 "$ strip from the background fabric. Strip piece these units to create a ribbon with the feature fabric in the center. Cut $21 / 2 "$ units from this strip. You will need 2 of these units per block you are making. Set aside.

Cut a $21 / 2 "$ strip from your feature fabric. Then cut a $21 / 2 "$ strip from your background fabric and an $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip from your background fabric. Assemble these pieces in the same way as described above and cut $21 / 2 "$ units from the strip. You will need 2 of these units per block you are making. Set aside.

Your two units should look like this


You will need $24161 / 2$ " units and $24121 / 2 "$ for 12 blocks, 12 of each for 6 blocks, and 8 of each for 4 blocks.
