STEP 3

Cut a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip from your feature fabric. Then cut a 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip from the background fabric and a 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip from the background fabric. Strip piece these units to create a ribbon with the feature fabric in the center. Cut 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " units from this strip. You will need 2 of these units per block you are making. Set aside.

Cut a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip from your feature fabric. Then cut a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip from your background fabric and an 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip from your background fabric. Assemble these pieces in the same way as described above and cut 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " units from the strip. You will need 2 of these units per block you are making. Set aside.

Your two units should look like this

You will need 24 16 ½" units and 24 12 ½" for 12 blocks, 12 of each for 6 blocks, and 8 of each for 4 blocks.
