STEP 6

Assemble your blocks in rows and then border as suggested below. If you would like to do something different for borders, make sure you have enough yardage, but be creative!

Square up your quilt center as needed before sewing your borders on.

For borders, cut strips from your feature fabric that are $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x the width of the fabric. For a 12 block quilt you will probably need 6 cuts. Miter or square your corners, as you prefer.

Attach the strips to all 4 sides.

Cut strips from your background fabric that measure $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x the width of the fabric and attach to all 4 sides. Again, miter or square the corners as desired. You will need 6 cuts to make this border.

Your top is complete. I've included enough yardage for the feature fabric to allow for you to use it for the binding.

Quilt as desired.
