PARCHEESI – A Mystery Quilt Designed by Kathryn Greenwold QUILT-Schenectady Guild Mystery Challenge 2012-13 © 2012

Cut your fabrics #3 and #4 into squares that measure 3 ³/₄" x 3 ³/₄". You will need 20 squares of each fabric. You will once again mark and cut an "X" through the light fabric once the squares have been sewn together.

Repeat the process described in Part 2 creating 20 blocks that measure $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $4 \frac{1}{2}$ ". Refer back to **figures 2, 3, and 4**. (See Part 2 instructions).

Trim these blocks down to measure 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " as needed. Press the seams out to the points of the blocks.
