

Big Kid Quilts = 54" x 72"

Use 9" blocks, 9-patch and alternates, set 5 x 7 Add a 4½" border (cut 5") -- total size 54" x 72" Yardage: 9-patch -- 1 yard dark, 3/4 yard light

Alternate blocks: 1/2 yards

Borders: 1 yard -- Binding: 1/2 yard



Little Kid Quilts = 42" x 60"

Use 6" blocks, 9-patch and alternates, set 7 x 10 Yardage: 9-patch -- 1 yard dark, 3/4 yard light

Alternate blocks: 14 yards

Binding: 1/2 yard

How? For Big-Kid Quilt: cut 3½" strips, 8 dark and 7 light

make 3 sets.....to make 36

32"cuts make 2 sets.....to make 18



Also cut 5 9½" strips of plain fabric, then cut them into 17 9½" squares. Assemble 9-patches and alternate blocks, 5 across and 7 down.

Add 45" (cut 5") borders.

For Little-Kid Quilts: cut 2½" strips, 13 dark, 11 light

make 5 sets.....to make 70 make 3 sets.....to make 35 マスセ"Cuts

Cut 6 62" strips of plain fabric, then cut into 35 alternate squares. Assemble 9-patches and alternate blocks, 7 across and 10 down. Add no border

VARIATION......Use same 9-patches and same yardage for B.K. and L.K. quilts as above. The only change is in the alternate block, which is pieced instead of plain. New alternate block yardage, 1 yard light, 1/2 yard dark for both sizes.

Make sets as follows:

B.K.

Cut strips 3½"

Make 5 sets Cut 17 95" blocks L.K.

Cut strips 23" Make 6 sets

Cut 35 6½" blocks
