### **QUILT Schenectady Mystery Quilt 2014-15**

#### **PART 6 – February**

All that remains is to add borders to your top and then get the quilting completed. I've designed two simple border, but this is a place where you could get creative if you have a little extra yardage or blocks.

#### **For the Large Size quilt cut:**

7 strips of Border 1 Fabric to 2 ½" x WOF.

8 Strips of Border 2 Fabric to 5 ½" x WOF

#### **For the Small Size quilt cut:**

6 strips of Border 1 Fabric to 1 ½" x WOF

7 strips of Border 2 Fabric to 4 ½" x WOF

For both the Larger and Smaller versions of this pattern:

Square up the interior of your quilt before adding the borders. This will help avoid wavy edges.

Sew three of the Border 1 strips together. Cut two units to about 1" longer than the top and bottom measurement of the quilt top. Sew these units in place and trim. Press the seams to the border fabric. Add the remaining strips to the remainder of the first 3-piece unit and cut two units 1" longer than the side measurement. Sew these strips in place and press to the border fabric.

Follow the same process with the Border 2 strips.

Your quilt is now complete. Happy Quilting! Can't wait to see the end results in June.
