Part 3 – November

We had a great show, congratulations to everyone and thanks also for all the work we did together pull it off. Now it's time to start working on new things! This month you will be working on block 2 for this year's Mystery. It's another simple process so that you can also enjoy Thanksgiving with family and friends.

Step 1

Use the pieced $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares you made last month and the solid $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares of Fabrics A and B you cut in Month 1 to create this block. Set them together in the layout shown in Figure 1 below. Sew each row and then complete the block by sewing the rows together to create a Friendship Star block. Press your seams outward in Rows 1 and 3 and to the center in Row 2. This will assist in "snugging" the rows together.

Be careful to orient the pieced squares properly in each block to create the star pattern.

Large Quilt

You need 15 of these blocks.

Small Quilt

You need 10 of these blocks.

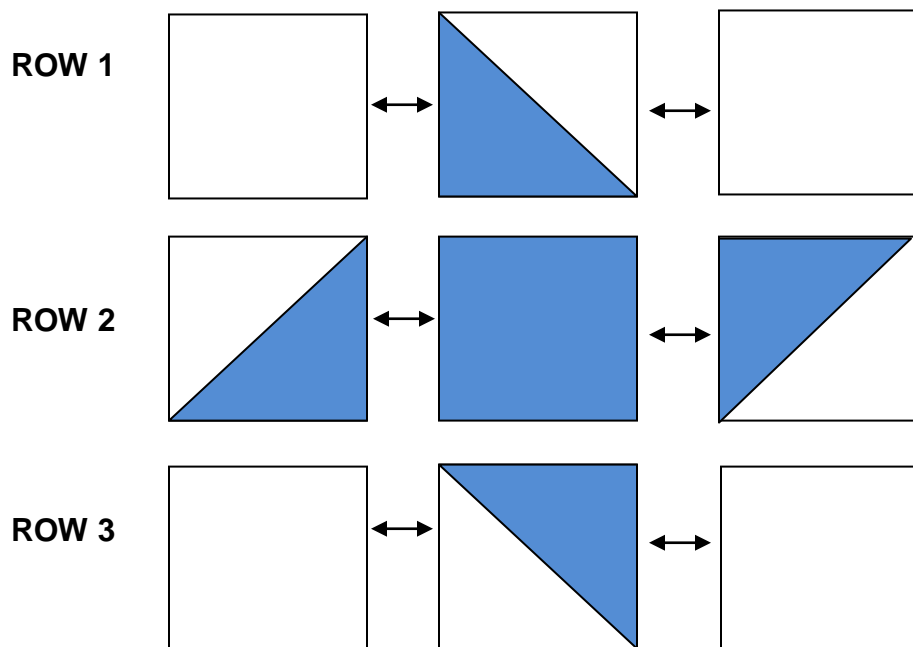
