

# QUILTS FOR KIDS: PIECED-HEARTS QUILT

Little Kids: using a 9" block set as shown at right  
— plus 2" double-borders (4" per side) = 46 x 59"

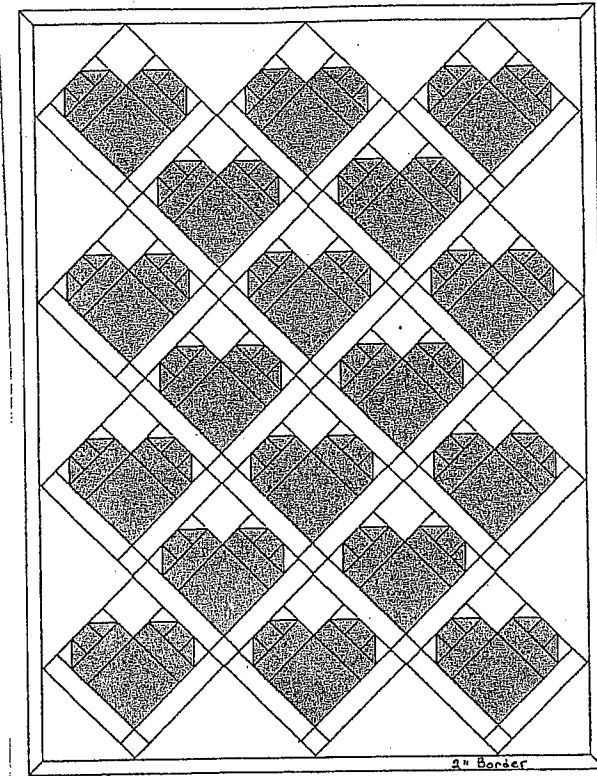
Big Kids: 12" block with single 2" borders = 55 x 70"

Using all scraps, each heart blocks uses::  
One 7" strip of both heart and background cut across  
a full width of fabric yields 2 12" blocks.  
One 5" strip of both heart and background cut across  
a full width of fabric yields 2 9" blocks..

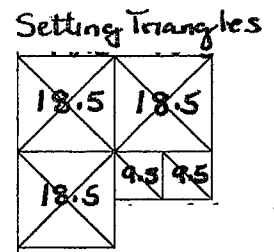
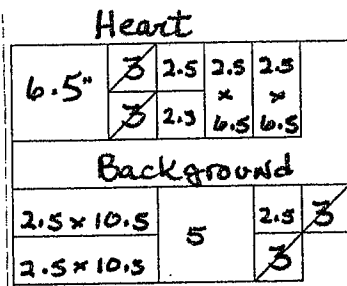
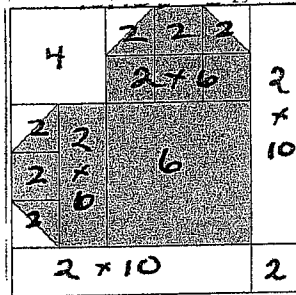
If you use one consistent background:  
For 12" block, get 1 3/4 yards  
For 9" block, get 1 1/2 yards

For corner and side-setting triangles:  
1 1/8 yards for the 12" blocks  
1 yard for the 9" blocks

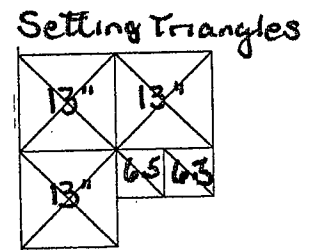
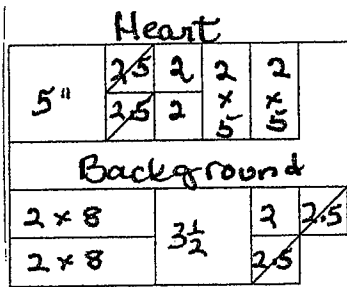
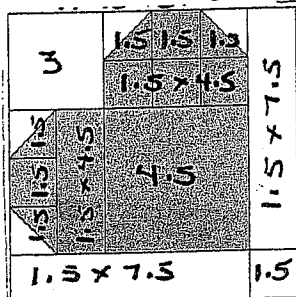
These will be large squares cut diagonally  
into half-square or quarter-square triangles.

Follow the quilt diagram to piece the diagonal rows.
