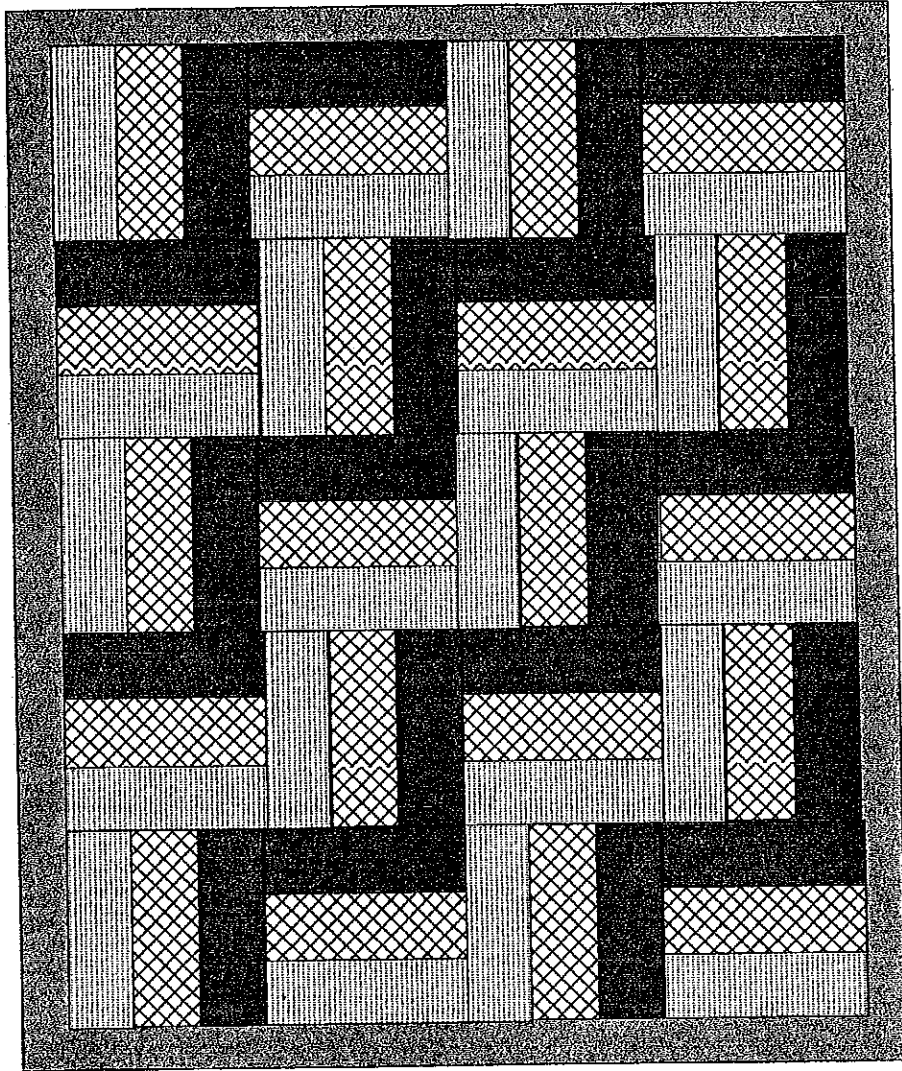


**RAIL FENCE QUILT**  
**Finished size, 54"x66"**  
**20 blocks, 12 1/2" square**  
**("Big Kid" donation quilt)**



**Materials needed:**

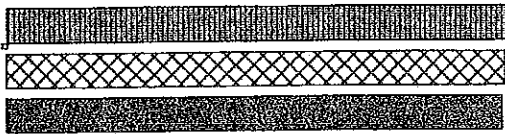
- 1 1/8 yd (40 inches) rail color A
- 1 1/8 yd (40 inches) rail color B
- 1 1/8 yd (40 inches) rail color C
- 1 yd sash fabric
- Please include 4 yds backing/binding fabric if possible

## **PRE-CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS TO MAKE KIT:**

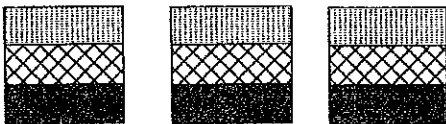
- 1. Rail Color A--after removing the selvages, cut the fabric into 9 (4 1/2") strips down its LENGTH, not its width. There will be a few inches of waste fabric left over.**
- 2. Rail Colors B and C--repeat step 1, remembering to cut down the LENGTH of the fabric, not the width.**
- 3. Sashing--cut ACROSS THE WIDTH for this! Cut 8 strips 3 1/2" wide. There will be a few inches of fabric left over.**

## **SEWING INSTRUCTIONS TO MAKE QUILT TOP:**

- 1. Sew one strip A to B, and these two to strip C along the long edges, using 1/4" seam. Press each seam toward the darker fabric.**



- 2. Slice each strip set into 12 1/2" sections. (You will get 3 sections plus extra inches from each strip set.) Lay out the sections in an alternating pattern as shown in the diagram on the front.**



- 3. Sew the blocks together in rows, and press the seams toward the vertical strips (This will make the seams lay flat when rows are joined.)**
- 4. When all 5 rows are assembled and joined, add the sashing. Two strips of sashing should be joined together at the 3 1/2" ends for each edge of the quilt top. Either add both top and bottom sections first, or both sides first. All the strips should be trimmed even with the quilt top before going on.**
