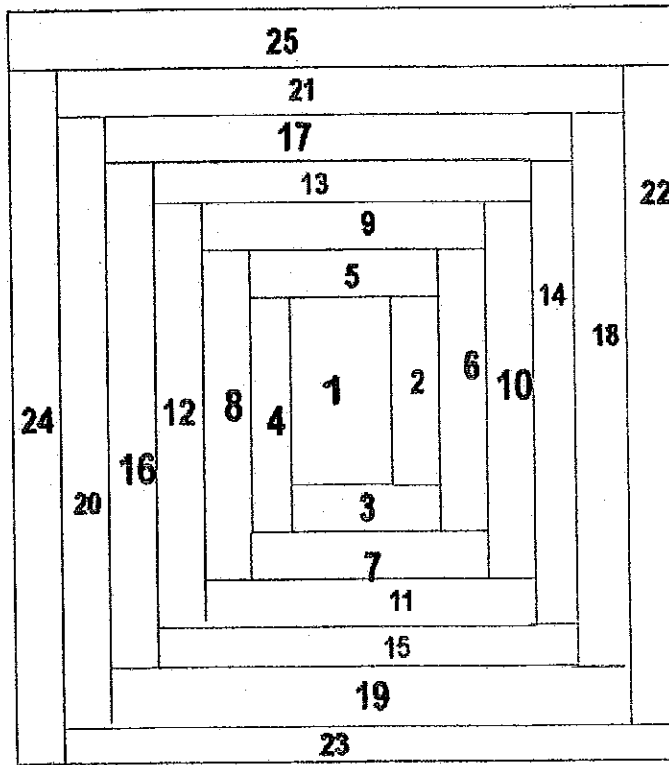


Kit Building: STRIP AROUND THE WORLD

This is a great scrap quilt, for it uses continuous strips of fabric that wrap their way around a center rectangle. You can make this as large as you want. These instructions make a finished top 42" x 60" for a **little kid quilt**. At the end of the instructions are the modifications you could do to make it 54"x72" for a big kid's quilt.



* Cut one block
6 ½"x12 ½" for the
center

* For the remainder
of the quilt, cut strips
3 ½" wide. Total
length should be
approx. 13 yds of
strips.

(For big kids' quilt,
you will need an
additional 7 yds of
strips)

If possible, please include
backing and binding
fabric: 2 yards for small
quilt, 4 ½ yds. for large
one

Assembly Directions: (use ¼" seams throughout)

*Start with block #1, the center. Add one length of strip (#2) to one long side of the center block. Press seam toward strip. Trim excess strip even with the center block.

* Continue adding, pressing, and trimming strips in the numbered sequence. If you need to, piece together more than one fabric to complete the strip needed. This is truly a scrappy quilt!

(For Big Kids' quilt, continue adding 2 more strips to each side, going around the world in the same manner as above.)
