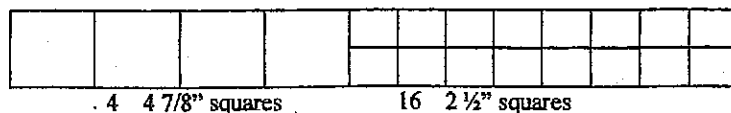


BUCKEYE BEAUTY

You will be making FOUR 8" blocks, sewing these into ONE 16" square.

Cut from muslin: 4 - 4 7/8" squares
16 - 2 1/2" squares



Cut from your scraps of assorted prints:

4 - 4 7/8" sq
16 - 2 1/2" sq

On **WRONG** side of muslin 4 7/8" sq: draw diagonal line with marker.

Place muslin square on scrap 4 7/8" square.

With **RIGHT** sides together, sew 1/4" seam on each side of marked line.

Cut apart on marked line. Press open to make Half Square Triangle blocks.

Make 8 Triangle Blocks. [see diagram 1]

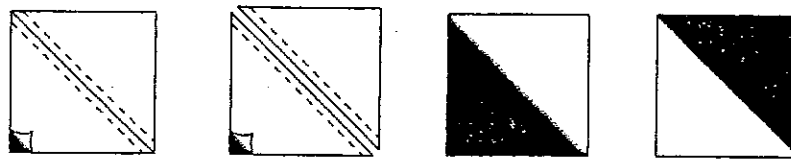
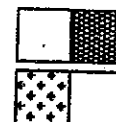


Diagram 1

Using the 16 2 1/2" Muslin squares & 16 2 1/2" Scrap squares: Sew into pairs as shown below.
Then join pairs to make a Four Patch. Make 8.

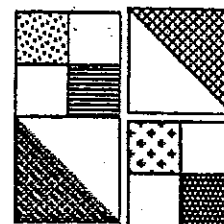


Take 2 Four Patches and 2 Half Square Triangle blocks.

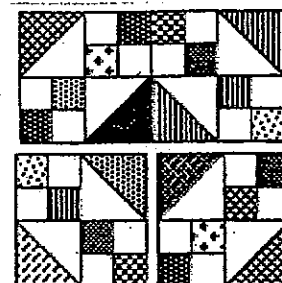
Join them in pairs as shown [diagram to the right]

Then join the pairs to make a Buckeye Beauty block.

Make 4 blocks.



Place 4 Buckeye Beauty blocks together to make a 4 block unit.
The dark triangle should form a square "on point" in the center of the unit.



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
